The Jane A. Yuhouse Memorial Scholarship was established to honor a loving wife, mother and friend who had a passion for baking, traveling and helping others in need. Jane grew up in Alverton and was a graduate of the Southmoreland Class of 1975.

Family and friends would tell you that Jane was very caring and willing to help anyone who needed any type of assistance. From baking for events, making donations that supported women and children in need, or supporting environmental causes, everyone knew that Jane's heart was in it to help those in need.

Jane's baking talents was something she was known for, especially her cookies that she would make and share around the holidays, for weddings and for community organizations and events. She grew up learning family recipes from her aunts and grandmother and has shared these recipes with her nieces and nephews.

Jane was an avid traveler, finding sights off the beaten path that many would pass by. Many of Jane's travel itineraries included stops to National Parks with her family and friends. Jane, her husband and son, traveled to 50 states, seeing some of America's greatest treasures and some off-the-wall travel stops that would often become the highlight of the trip. Jane was an advocate for the National Park Service and conservation efforts. She supported organizations with shared goals and values for preserving wildlife, resources and National sites.

Not only was Jane a strong supporter of the Scottdale Historical Society, but she also valued and supported the work done by Habitat for Humanity, women and children support organizations that cared for the abused or those in need, animal rescue organizations, and many others. Jane would volunteer with the Scottdale Historical Society and support events held at the Loucks House, often times by baking for private and public functions.

The Jane A. Yuhouse Memorial Scholarship is offering up to a \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating Southmoreland High School Senior(s) who shares similar interests and values as Jane, and who is continuing their education in the Culinary Arts, Environmental Sciences (conservation, park services, parks and recreation, etc.), Social Sciences (geographical studies) or Health and Human Service (social work, child development, counseling, case worker, child abuse worker, etc.) fields.

Applicants must have a 3.0 overall GPA. Applicants must submit a completed application, letters of reference, a copy of their acceptance letter from the trade school/college/university they will be attending, current school transcript, a current photo and a one page essay. Completed applications should be returned into the Guidance Office by April 20, 2020.
