Dual Enrollment >>>


In partnership with Penn State University Fayette Campus, Southmoreland School District offers students the ability to take college courses while still in high school.

Engaging students >>>

Courses are offered through an online environment using both synchronous and asynchronous instruction. The online courses from Southmoreland are robust and interactive.
